BOND MARKET

The 10-year benchmark recorded a close of 6.3700%, ending at 1.95 bps higher than the close of the previous day's trading session.

DOMESTIC BROADCAST

India's industrial production expanded by 1.5% from the previous year in June of 2025, picking up from the 1.2% increase in the previous month. Still, the growth was below expectations of a sharper 2% to mark the lowest industrial expansion since the stall in August 2024. Output growth was solely supported by the manufacturing sector, (3.9% vs 3.2% in May), offsetting contractions for mining (-8.7% vs -0.1%), likely aligned with the drop in coal prices and softer export demand from China, in addition electricity (-2.6% vs -4.7%).

On JULY 25, the RBI reported ₹ 600423.27, at 5.35% of market activity in the overnight and term segments. Under RBI operations, MSF saw ₹125008 crore at 5.25%, and SDF saw ₹161300 crore at 5.25%. The net liquidity absorbed totaled ₹287763.79 crore.

GLOBAL BROADCAST

European markets posted modest gains while the euro fell, as investors reacted with cautious relief to a new U.S.-EU trade agreement. The STOXX 600 rose 0.5% to a four-month high, while the euro dropped 0.7%, its biggest fall in months. The trade deal, seen as damage control rather than a breakthrough, imposes a 15% tariff on most EU goods and includes \$600 billion in EU investments in the U.S. Despite preventing a more severe trade standoff, critics argue it heavily favors Washington.

Meanwhile, the U.S. dollar strengthened on solid jobs data, and global equities were mixed. Wall Street futures pointed to fresh highs, while Asia saw declines, with Japan's Nikkei down over 1%. Investors now await key events including U.S. and Japan central bank meetings, U.S. payroll data, and earnings from major tech firms. Both central banks are expected to hold rates, though future guidance will be closely watched. Oil prices edged up on easing trade tensions, while gold dipped to a two-week low on reduced demand for safe-haven assets.

SPREAD ANALYSIS

MARKET OUTLOOK
